## Your Mercy and Your Justice PSALM 101



#### Refrain

What is the aim of the ninth commandment? That I never give false testimony against anyone, twist no one's words, not gossip or slander, nor join in condemning anyone rashly or without a hearing.

#### Refrain

I will sing of your love and justice; to you, LORD, I will sing praise. I will be careful to lead a blameless life when will you come to me? I will conduct the affairs of my house with a blameless heart. I will not look with approval on anything that is vile. I hate what faithless people do; I will have no part in it. The perverse of heart shall be far from me; I will have nothing to do with what is evil.

Whoever slanders their neighbor in secret, I will put to silence; whoever has haughty eyes and a proud heart, I will not tolerate. My eyes will be on the faithful in the land. that they may dwell with me; the one whose walk is blameless will minister to me. No one who practices deceit will dwell in my house: no one who speaks falsely will stand in my presence. Every morning I will put to silence all the wicked in the land: I will cut off every evildoer from the city of the Lord.
